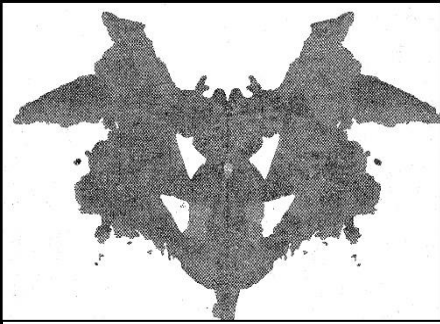

"Brett took his vorpal sword in hand; Long time the Frankenfeinstein foe he fought.

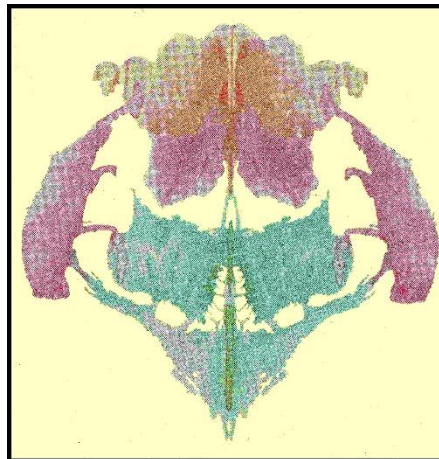
One, two! One, two! And through and through
